Objective of the course

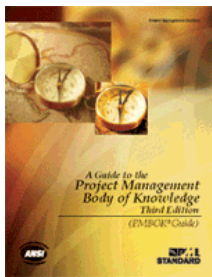


The course has one main objective:

To prepare participants to take and pass the PMP® Certification Exam.

Content



The areas covered are all five Process Groups (Initiate, Plan, Execute, Control and Close) as well as the nine Knowledge Areas (Communication, Time, Cost, Scope, Integration, Human Resources, Risk, Quality, Procurement) and Professional Responsibility. Contrary to most courses, ProPMP approaches the information by Process Group – a more logical and useful approach for the Project Manager.

The course content is based upon the PM Book of Knowledge - Third Edition (PMBOK® - the official PMI guide to Project Management, and the basis for all Certification questions), and also includes all supplementary information needed to pass the exam.

Method



This course uses a blended learning approach: a well-balanced mix of classroom training and self-study using probably one of the best web-based tools for the exam preparation.
